Purpose of Post

Under the guidance of senior staff, the Cleaning Supervisor will have responsibility for the day to day management of the cleaning team, ensuring a clean and hygienic school environment which meets the specified cleaning standards.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities

1. Main Responsibilities

- Carry out general cleaning duties.
- Use electrical cleaning equipment as appropriate.
- Maintain correct levels of materials and equipment.
- Ensure the safe use of all machinery, equipment and chemicals.
- Keep external areas of the premises clean and tidy.
- Carry out various janitorial and portering duties.
- The post-holder may be required to be a key-holder.
- Report any incidents/problems to senior staff.
- Organise and supervise staff, ensuring cleaning is in accordance with the agreed specification.
- Prepare and maintain the necessary staff records.
- Organise the allocation of duties to ensure that all designated areas are cleaned.
- Co-ordinate periodic cleaning as required.
- Inspect and monitor standards of cleaning.
- Ensure that all health and safety policies are adhered to by staff.

2. Other Responsibilities

- Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, health, safety and security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting all concerns to an appropriate person.
- Be aware of and support difference and ensure equal opportunities for all.
- Contribute to the overall ethos/work/aims of the school.
- Appreciate and support the role of other professionals.

- Attend and participate in relevant meetings as required.
- Participate in training and other learning activities and performance development as required.

3. Safeguarding
